### Journey Through The Covers Volume 1

The Gjenvick-Gjonvik Archives, established in 2000, provides extraordinary access to ephemera from the steamship companies, dating from the 1870s through 1954. This book represents the first volume of amazing graphics that adorned the covers of brochures and passenger lists from this era.

Early passenger lists were handwritten but once printing presses became commonplace on many steamships, the passenger lists became a souvenir of the voyage. The covers of many of the older passenger lists contained superb graphics and are highly prized by collectors.

The GG Archives has an extensive collection of passenger lists in our Maritime Collection. Our largest holdings are for the Cunard Line / Cunard White Star Line.

The lists of passengers vary considerably between steamship lines in terms of information provided on each passenger. Additionally, on many voyages, each class received a separate passenger list while others combined multiple classes into one or two passenger lists for the same voyage.

Today, the passenger lists and brochures from the steamship companies are prized by collectors for their rich graphics.
